

Minutes of Meeting

- i) Bhota Hospital is providing routine services to the patients and disposing of the bio medical waste thus generated as per the bio-medical waste management rules. The bio-medical waste management committee members were advised to refresh their SOPs of Bio Medical Waste Management and ensure their compliance by the staff.
- ii) A refresher training for all health care workers is being conducted in small batches to make them aware about the current practices in BMW Management and the SOPs to be followed for the same.
- iii) Bio Medical waste is being collected by the CBMWT Contractor. Contract for the year 2021-22 has been renewed for one year with Suraksha Bio Sanitizer, Gaggal w.e.f 1st April 2021.
- iv) Committee members were advised to update their bio-medical waste log books regularly.
- v) Weekly spore testing is required for the dedicated autoclave for Bio-Medical Waste. Since culture of spores has been discontinued in Bhota Hospital due to non availability of Pathologist, therefore the culture ^{will be} done by SRL.
- vi) NS. Atrika has updated the Hepatitis B and Tetanus Immunisation record of Healthcare workers. All members have been advised to ensure immunisation of left out staff if any.
- vii) As a part of bio safety Bio Medical Waste management is required to ensure safety of patients, visitors and other people in the surrounding localities:

- viii) To meet above requirement meticulous disinfection and sterilisation of Bio Medical Waste is indispensable as is equipment and inventory management.
- ix) Safe storage of Biomedical waste should be ensured at all the times. The onsite storage space should not be accessible to un-authorized persons.
- x) Regular training programs have been resumed for newly inducted staff to make them aware about BMW Management Rules and procedures at the induction to avoid any mistakes.
- xi) All employees likely to be deputed to medical wing should be immunised before deputing to ensure their safety.
- xii) As per BMW Management Amendment 2019, in Rule 4 which specifies the Duties of the occupier: for clause (n), the following clause, shall be substituted, namely: "(n), in case of all bedded health care units, maintain and update on day to day basis the bio-medical waste management register and display the monthly record on its website according to the bio-medical waste generated in terms of category and colour coding as specified in Schedule-I".
- xiii) For clause (p), the following clause shall be substituted, namely: "(p) ,in case of all bedded health care facilities (any number of beds), make available the annual report on its web-site within a period of two years from the date of publication of the Bio-Medical Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2018".
